A quality brush will hold a lot of paint, promote smooth strokes, and not shed or split. Natural bristle brushes are made of coarse animal hair and are suitable for oil and acrylic paints. High-quality paint brushes have bristle tips with marked or split ends that hold their shape and help hold and distribute paint better. The silver cap on the brush handle, called a ferrule, keeps the bristles in shape and maintains their flexibility. The most versatile is the trusty flat head brush. Choose the best paintbrush for your project.

Types of brushes

- Natural bristle brushes made from animal hair are used to apply oil-based paints, varnishes, bug spray, polyurethane and other oil-based finishes. The natural "markings" (split or fuzzy tips) of these brushes form split ends in the bristles that hold more paint and help ensure a smooth paint release and finish.
- Hybrid nylon/polyester brushes are easy to clean and work well with all types of latex paint. The
 combination of nylon's durability and polyester's conformability is the hallmark of a high-quality brush it also produces a high-quality paint finish. What's more, these durable brushes are designed to
 handle a multitude of projects. As a result, nylon/polyester brushes should last for years if properly





cared for.

 Polyester brushes are best suited for latex paints. These brushes retain their shape and stiffness in any paint and apply paint smoothly and evenly.

Brush size

Qianmiao brushes range in width from 1 to 4 inches. The size you choose is up to you, but a good rule of thumb is.

- 1" to 2" for windows and other small decorations
- 3" Glossy paint for doors and cabinets
- 4" for large, flat areas

Brush head types

- Chisel Trim Brush Angled bristles produce good straight lines for trimming corners and edges.
- Square Trimmer Brush- Bristles have squared-off ends and are primarily used for applying paint to flat areas.
- Angled brushes Bristles are cut to make it easier to apply paint to the window trim.
