If the examination is successful, your trademark is published in the Trademark Journal. This publication allows third parties to oppose the trademark within a specific period (usually 3-4 months).

Step 5: Registration and Issuance of the Trademark Certificate

If no opposition is filed or if the opposition is resolved in your favor, the trademark is registered, and a certificate is issued. It is important to maintain your trademark by renewing it every 10 years.
